








Allemond is a charming village where people take it easy, making it an **ideal base camp for exploring the Oisans Alpine region**. Situated at an altitude of 713 m, the village **offers easy access to the entire valley**.

It's a starting point for cyclists riding through the Glandon and Croix de Fer passes, as well as for a vast network of marked trails through the Grandes Rousses and Belledonne mountains.

In winter and summer alike, there are free shuttles to take you to the mountain bike and ski areas of Alpe d'Huez Grand Domaine, via Vaujany, Oz-en-Oisans, and Villard-Reculas.


Find any mountain sport you want around Allemond.

Cycling, mountain biking, and hiking are just some of the activities you can enjoy in the heart of this village! But that's not all: Allemond also offers a water sports centre and swimming pool, an impressive climbing wall, many other activities, and evening events. In winter, the ski slopes are nice and close.

You can reach Alpe d'Huez Grand Domaine ski resort in 8 minutes with the new "Eau d'Olle Express" gondola lift, open throughout the winter and summer seasons.

THE RESORTS & VILLAGES OF OISANS

A true paradise for lovers of wide open spaces, of gentle pleasures or sensational thrills, and of breathtaking scenery, this corner of the French Alps straddles the departments of Isère (38), Hautes-Alpes (05), and Savoie (73).

The geographic location of Oisans offers the perfect climate, as you'll find plenty of sunshine throughout much of the year—300 hours on average in high-altitude resorts like Alpe d'Huez!

The mountain area boasts four ski areas (Alpe d'Huez Grand Domaine, Les 2 Alpes, La Grave, and Col d'Ornon) and dozens of resorts and villages in the region's valleys or perched in the mountains.





At the heart of Oisans is a network of linked resorts.

THE FIRST OF A NEW GENERATION OF GONDOLA LIFTS, THE EAU D'OLLE EXPRESS LINKS ALLEMOND TO THE RESORT OF OZ-EN-OISANS!

Since December 2020, a next-generation gondola lift links Allemond to Oz-en-Oisans in 8 minutes, instead of 20 minutes by road, providing the shortest, most direct, and safest access route to the Oz-Vaujany and Alpe d'Huez Grand Domaine ski areas.

By providing a fast, safe, and environmentally-friendly link between the valley and the high-altitude resorts, the Eau d'Olle Express is a concrete example of how travel practices are changing, with the aim of creating a zero-carbon mountain destination.



SHUTTLE FROM OISANS HYDRELEC (VAUJANY) TO VENOSC (LES 2 ALPES)

The (free) Oisans shuttle takes you across the Oisans plain to the two lifts in Allemond and Venosc.

The shuttle offers 47 seats and a ski locker, operates seven days a week, and is accessible for people with reduced mobility.

10 stops served: Les 2 Alpes via the Venosc gondola lift, Les Ougiers, Le Clapier d'Auris, Bourg d'Oisans Sarenne roundabout, Bourg d'Oisans bus station, Bourg d'Oisans La Paute, Bourg d'Oisans Eglise des Sables church, Bourg d'Oisans Rochetaillée, Allemond Eau d'Olle Express car park, Vaujany Le Verney Musée Hydrélec.

THE EMPARIS PLATEAU

A sea of greenery certified by Natura 2000.

Lake Lérié and Lake Noir offer fantastic views of the ridges of the northern face of La Meije and Le Râteau (3,809 m).



LAKE DU LAUVITEL

The largest lake in the Écrins mountains

At an altitude of 1,530 m, this emerald mirror set among lush green peaks is one of the most beautiful spots in the Oisans region and can be reached in an hour and a half of hiking.



LA MEIJE

Queen Meije!

Meije means "midday" and also refers to the south, thus owing its name to the sun that passes over it at midday.



THE ECRINS NATIONAL PARK

The oldest and largest national park in mainland France.

Created in March 1973, it covers 61 towns and straddles two departments: Isère and Hautes-Alpes. It is made up of seven valleys.



LE PIC BLANC

An exceptional 360° view of 1/5th of France!

Rising to an altitude of 3,330 metres in the heart of the Grandes Rousses massif, the Pic Blanc offers a panoramic view as far as the eye can see across an ocean of mountain peaks!



THE CLIMB TO ALPE D'HUEZ

21 Bends & the Tour de France! Alpe d'Huez and its 21 bends are one of the Tour de France's most iconic stages. Cyclists follow 21 signs as they cruise along a 14-km route that spans 1,120 m of altitude.

GLANDON PASS & CROIX DE FER PASS

A re-energising parade of greenery.

The Glandon Pass (1,924 m) and the Croix de Fer Pass (2,064 m), located 2 km apart, link the Isère and Savoie departments, between the Oisans and Maurienne regions.




LAUTARET & GALIBIER PASSES

A strategic route via one of the few roads that cross the Alps... The names Lautaret and Galibier have a mythical ring to them, thanks to the high mountain atmosphere and the landscapes crossed on both sides of the passes.



THE ICE CAVES

Ephemeral sculptures in the ice caves of Oisans. Let yourself be surprised by the softness of the snow, the warmth of the ice, and your imagination, and discover the secrets of the glaciers at La Grave, Les 2 Alpes, and Alpe d'Huez.



LA BÉRARDE, 1,720 M

The mecca of mountaineering. At the heart of the Ecrins mountains, where the spirit of the place still resonates with the names of famous mountaineers, this is a place of freedom and encounters for all mountain lovers.

CRISS-CROSS THE VAST AREA!

- > 10,000 hectares, of which 840 are skiable,

- > 2,200 m of altitude change, from 3,330 m at the summit of Pic Blanc to 1,135 m at the Enversin d'Oz.

To offer you endless thrills, five resorts and two villages joined forces to create the Alpe d'Huez "Grand Domaine" ski area: **Alpe d'Huez, Auris-en-Oisans, La Garde, Le Freney d'Oisans, Oz-en-Oisans, Vaujany, and Villard-Reculas.**

Long downhill runs and huge altitude changes for long-lasting skiing fun!
What's special about this ski area is that you can ski for many kilometres without taking any lifts!

Fans of long descents can choose from five itineraries covering around 10,000 metres of altitude changes. The ski area includes **17 black pistes**, including legendary routes such as the 16-km **Sarenne piste**, not to mention the **Tunnel piste**, which crosses through the mountain from side to side and leads to one of the steepest walls in French skiing, at a 35° incline.

SKI AREAS ACCESSIBLE FROM ALLEMOND

In addition to the Alpe d'Huez "Grand Domaine" ski area, **8 minutes from Allemond with the EAU D'OLLE EXPRESS, discover other fabulous skiing destinations:**

> La Grave — La Meije: an off-piste skiing area that's unique in Europe, a legendary gondola lift, and La Meije. It's truly one-of-a-kind. It offers a vast off-piste area, unique in Europe, where you can ski in total freedom! Two small runs groomed on the glacier, and that's it: the rest is up to you from the top of a gondola lift that's every bit as legendary as the ski area itself.

> **43 mins by car via the D1091 road**

> Les 2 Alpes: a leading snow park, a glacier at 3,600 m, and summer skiing. Welcome to the Lauze glacier at 3,600 m of altitude. The longest ski run has a vertical descent of 2,300 m, finishing at Mont de Lans at 1,300 m. With natural snow guaranteed thanks to the glacier (3,600 m), Les 2 Alpes ski area is a veritable paradise for skiers, spread over 410 hectares of marked runs.

> **35 mins by car via the D1091 road**

> Col d'Ornon: a human-scale Nordic skiing and snowshoeing kingdom in a wooded environment. A small, family-friendly resort that holds its own against the big-name resorts nearby. You'll find the same mountain activities here, but on a human scale! The Col d'Ornon resort, just an hour from Grenoble, offers a full range of outdoor activities: skiing (Alpine and Nordic), snowshoeing, dog sledding, horse riding, hiking, tobogganing, mountain biking, and more. Also of note, the resort offers great courses for beginners, as well as a variety of marked runs.

> **25 mins by car via the D1091 + D526 roads**

- > Vaujany Sports & Leisure Centre.
- > **13 mins – 8 km via the Col du Sabot road, then D43A and D526 roads**

A whole host of activities to enjoy and discover!

- A large 25-metre pool with four swimming lanes for athletes, a water slide, a waterfall, and a beach set up in summer with a view of the Grandes Rousses Massif, all in water at 30°C!
- An international indoor ice rink measuring 58 x 28 m, where you can give skating a try all year round with help from a skating aid, made available free of charge, or have fun with friends during an evening of entertainment.
- The bowling alley, housed in the ice rink building, offers a modern, colourful setting for games with family and friends.
- The completely renovated La Fare Spa offers you a unique place to recharge your batteries and enjoy a truly relaxing break. It comprises a wellness area with a sauna, steam bath, two hot tubs, and a herbal tea room, as well as a treatment room. Access for people aged 16 years and older, as well as children accompanied by an adult.
- The multi-purpose room is open all year round, offering badminton, basketball, volleyball, handball, futsal, floorball... and a climbing wall!

WINTER ACTIVITIES



From Allemond, snow permitting, you can enjoy snowshoeing along the river embankment, on the shores of Lake Verney, or along the "squirrel trail" at Pont Rouge. You can then follow the Plateau des Lacs route at 2,000 metres above sea level.

Accessible from Vaujany or Oz-en-Oisans, this wild plateau is far from the ski lifts, with only footpaths and cross-country ski trails to remind you that civilisation is not far away. Accessible for all, the route is marked and completely safe. Along the way, take in the exceptional panoramic views of the Belledonne and Grandes Rousses mountains. In just a few minutes, you'll find yourself at an altitude of 2,000 m on the magnificent Plateau des Lacs.



Leaving from Allemond, the Plaine de l'Oisans Nordic skiing site is accessible to all, with loops marked out in alternating and skating steps through the forest, with no hazardous descents or endless climbs.



SUMMER ACTIVITIES



A major attraction in Allemond: one of the two water sports centres in the Oisans region, near the Verney dam!

Here you can pedal-boat, canoe, windsurf, sail a dinghy, paddle-board, and more. Or you can simply enjoy a family picnic near the pontoons or children's play area. The inviting atmosphere of the Parc des Tilleuls, with its 200-year-old trees, is the setting for many summer events. Right next door is a very accessible skate park, a tennis court, the swimming pool, the climbing wall, and stops for the shuttle bus, which will take you up to the mountain bike trails. Hiking options leaving from Allemond include everything from flat ground, perfect for pushchairs, to trails for keen walkers!

Lake Verney has naturally found its place in the Eau d'Olle valley, between the peaks of the Belledonne and Grandes Rousses mountains.

Built between 1979 and 1984 by the French electric utility EDF, this artificial reservoir seems to have always been there... Its cool waters, its colour changes throughout the year, and its position at the crossroads of the valley's four villages make it a relaxing place enjoyed by all.

The Lake Verney water sports centre welcomes guests all summer long for refreshing and fun activities. With sunbathing beaches, children's play areas, and green spaces nearby, it has everything you need for a relaxing day out. The beautiful turquoise expanse of the lake is an instant eye-catcher and immediately invites you to relax... Book a sailing class for your teenagers, follow the bike path with your little ones to the "Himalayan footbridge," and let the mountain lake work its magic...



ACCESSIBLE LEISURE ACTIVITIES AT THE FOOT OF THE MOUNTAINS!



Every day in July and August, the water sports centre is open from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. and offers a wide range of aquatic activities: canoeing, peddle-boating, dinghy sailing, kayaking, windsurfing, or paddle-boarding. The equipment is available for hire, but you can also learn from a professional thanks to windsurfing and dinghy-sailing courses. Even if swimming is prohibited, these activities on the water or by the lake guarantee a refreshing day out!



Oisans is a great hiking destination and Allemond is home to some natural gems!

Our favourite sites include the charming Cabane du Chateau mountain refuge, set in the middle of a clearing with rhododendrons and bilberry bushes as far as the eye can see, as well as Lake Belledonne, with its crystal-clear waters inviting you to meditate or re-energise.

Whether you're into cross-country, endurance, or downhill trekking, Allemond is the place to be for every type of trail. You have plenty of choices: from family walks on the plain, to the legendary "Mégavalanche" route (from Pic Blanc at 3,330 m to the finish in Allemond at 720 m, i.e., a 2,610-m descent).

To make the most of the Alpe d'Huez Grand Domaine mountain bike area, hop on the Eau d'Olle Express gondola to reach Oz-en-Oisans in just 8 minutes! With a pass, you can explore this exceptional area on fun, well-kept trails.

As a family, you'll love the relaxing walk to Champeau pond and Bâton waterfall, with the occasional chamois antelope sighting. From Le Rivier, a hamlet that has managed to remain a quiet, charming little place, the hikes are wild and the ibexes frolic along the 7 Laux trail.



LES 2 ALPES GOLF COURSE

A nine-hole course at an altitude of 1,650 m, in a magical setting facing the mythical mountain La Muzelle. It's a natural course where only greens and bunkers have been added!

ALPE D'HUEZ GOLF COURSE



CYCLING!

Allemond is a central starting point for discovering the **six valleys of Oisans**, its wild roads, and its **legendary mountain passes**, the Glandon, the Croix de Fer, the Galibier, and more.

Oisans has many **spectacular and majestic mountain roads**. From family rides around Lake Verney to legendary climbs up Alpe d'Huez and Lautaret Pass, cycling fans can pedal to their hearts' content!



LOCATION

The residential complex is ideally located in Allemmond. The gondola lift to the Alpe d'Huez Grand Domaine ski resort is a four-minute walk (450 m) from the complex, the water sports centre a five-minute bike ride or 12-minute walk (1 km), and the shops and restaurants are a five-minute walk away. The residential complex is the ideal base for a wide range of activities in both summer and winter.
